PENNDEL SWIM LEAGUE BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING MINUTES

(February 14, 2022)

The meeting was called to order at 6:36 pm.

Minutes: The January Board Minutes were reviewed and approved as amended.

Finance: The January Financial report was accepted as presented.

Commissioners Report: Rick C. reported that so far, the dual meets have gone very well. There was one dual meet that was using one of the makeup days because of conflicts. There were no fines issued to any of the teams. Ken B. reported that there were no issues with meets or fines assessed to teams. There were 2 dual meets that didn't happen because of COVID issues and scheduling conflicts.

Championships/Distance Meets: Carl S. discussed some issues with Championship entries, including the failure to carefully review entry confirmation reports. When entries are incorrect or missing, many teams reach out to the host at the last minute to request changes or to add entries. This practice causes significant burdens for the hosts. The Board discussed how to handle late entries and will encourage coaches to be more thorough and complete with entries, and to closely review the meet entry confirmation reports so that any errors can be addressed promptly and before established deadlines. The Championship meets that have been completed went well even though there were some schedule adjustments at the Monroe meet due to weather conditions.

Charley Hartley Update: The Charley Hartley Memorial Meet is finalized; it will be held at Ridley High School on February 25-27. Entries are progressing, currently 18 teams participating with approximately 600 Swimmers.
