<u>Open Board Positions and Election:</u> The Board discussed the upcoming spring meeting and the positive issue of having more interested people for the Board then currently open positions. <u>League Championships</u>: Following the February Board meeting Jenn W. went back to some of the feedback previously requested from the coaches and believes that the current meet format is in alignment with the majority of the coaches wishes. <u>Rules and By-laws:</u> There was some discussion regarding an existing League rule and the impact it has on entries for the League championship meets. Rick C. was going to review and circulate among the Board a possible change to present to the members at the spring meeting. There was also a suggestion that a new rule be presented to break ties for divisional places at the end of the dual meets.

<u>Charlie Hartley Recap:</u> Overall things went well, a couple of extra volunteers would have been helpful, in particular for the scoring tables.
